**The Violet Richardson Award** is a tribute to young women in ages 13-19 who are actively involved in volunteer work that significantly impacts their community or the world. Whether it's combating social issues like drugs, crime, and violence, advocating for environmental sustainability, or working towards ending discrimination and poverty, your contribution is vital. Volunteer actions that benefit women, girls, and/or children are especially valued.

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this prestigious award, you must:

- Be a young woman between the ages of 13-19 volunteering to make a difference in your community.
- Reside or volunteer in Placer County.
- Have demonstrated initiative and leadership in identifying and solving community problems.
- Have significant accomplishments as a volunteer.

#### APPLICATION COMPONENTS

Your application should include the following:

##### Essay

Write an essay of up to 750 words describing your volunteer efforts and include the following:

Where do you volunteer and why?

Did you initiate the project? If so, why? What need were you fulfilling?

Describe the goals of the organization or project and its impact on the problems it addresses.

Explain your role as a volunteer and how long you have been volunteering.

Indicate how you are a team player.

How have you grown mentally and emotionally through this volunteerism?

What challenges did you overcome?

Please share with us your personal struggles if YOU HAVE ANY: at school, at home, and at your volunteer organization.

What does winning a cash award for \$500 mean to you?

How will you use the award to support/further your volunteer efforts?

Has this volunteerism helped you select your career path (yes or no, and why)?

Detail your accomplishments and contributions as a volunteer.

### **A Letter of Recommendation**

Your letter of recommendation should be from someone who is familiar with your volunteer work. It should describe how long the writer has known you, in what capacity they know you, and the outcome of your efforts.

Your letter of reference may not be a parent or relative.

### **Additional Materials**

You may include any supporting materials to strengthen your application, such as newspaper clippings, photographs, etc. These are optional but can provide a richer picture of your volunteer activities. Please ensure your name and phone number are included on all additional materials.

### **How to Apply**

Use the application sheet provided as the top cover sheet. Attach your essay, your letter(s) of recommendation, then any supporting materials.
